



## 12 July 2020: Ages 0-5

Hey Parents! Here is the guide for your Kidzone Online Experience.

### What we are learning:

**Bible Story:** I spy someone who made everything. Paul Teaches in Athens • Acts 17:16-34

**Memory Verse:** "These are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God." John 20:31, NLV

**Monthly Bottom Line:** I can believe in Jesus.

### How we are learning:

- Watch and engage in a time of worship by watching the worship video provided.
- Practice the memory verse together
- Watch the teaching video
- Do the activity together

### Activities:

#### Option 1: Teach!

**What You Need:** No supplies needed.

#### **What You Do:**

Before the Activity: Have your child stand in front of you.

During the Activity: Encourage your child to teach you about themselves. Have the child tell you the following things:

- Favorite color
- Favorite food
- What they like to do outside
- If they have a pet
- If they have brothers and sisters
- Favorite ice cream
- Favorite animal
- What they like to do with their family
- Favorite thing to do at church
- Favorite TV show

#### **What You Say:**

After the Activity: "That was so much fun! Today, we'll hear a Bible story about a man who went to a city to teach people all about Jesus!"

## **Option 2: Pass the Word Verse.**

**What You Need:** A Bible and a phone or music player for music

### **What You Do:**

*Before the Activity:* Stand with your child and other family members in a circle.

*During the Activity:* Play music as you pass the Bible around the circle. Stop the music randomly. When the music stops, instruct the person holding the Bible to open it. Then, say the memory verse together. Repeat several times.

### **What You Say:**

*Before the Activity: (Hold up the Bible.)* “Can anyone tell me what this is? *(Pause.)* Yes, this is the Bible! It’s God’s word to us and it’s true. We find our memory verse in the Bible. It says, ‘*These are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God,*’ John 20:31. Let’s pass the Bible around the circle. When the music stops, the person holding the Bible will open it like this *(demonstrate)*, and we will say the verse together.”

*After the Activity:* “That was SO fun! The Bible tells us about Jesus. When we read God’s words to us, we can believe in Jesus! **Who can believe in Jesus? [Bottom Line] I can believe in Jesus.**”
